Sustainability of transport and logistics



The concept of sustainability, although open to many interpretations, can be understood as based on two elements. The first is the transport network, which is, at the European level, fundamentally structured by the work carried out in recent years by the European Commission on the Trans-European Transportation Network (TEN-T).

The second element is made of the energy and telecommunications networks, which are elements of the digitalisation process. The transport network is dependent on the other two, both in terms of efficiency and sustainability.
