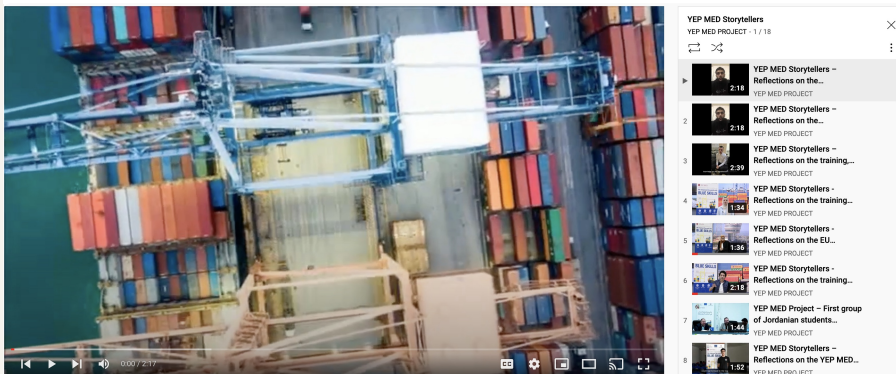
Lebanon: YEP MED and INTERNISA projects help the local youth in job placements

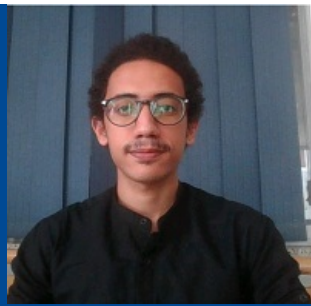
