World's 1st green methanol-powered containership docks in Egypt



The world's first containership powered by green methanol has reached East Port Said, Egypt, its third bunkering stop on its maiden journey from Ulsan, South Korea to Copenhagen, Denmark, through the fastest maritime crossing connecting East and West continents. The arrival of the vessel to Egypt coincides with a major expansion at the East Port Said, which is affiliated to SCZONE, including the integration between the port and the industrial zone in East Port Said. Specifically, Egypt is investing strenuous efforts to turn SCZONE into a clean energy production and green fuels hub.

## Sustainable Logistics Takes the Stage: Escola Europea to participate at SeaFocus ESG Summit







Scheduled for October 4th in Naantali, Finland, the Summit serves as a gathering of industry luminaries, experts, and professionals deeply committed to the principles of Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) within the maritime and logistics sectors.

The Port Training Institute has established a formidable international presence through extensive collaborations with countries worldwide, encompassing conferences, joint courses, and international projects. Notably, they have played a pivotal role in the EU's YEPMED project, which focuses on preparing and training youth for employment in ports, in collaboration with partners from the southern and northern Mediterranean regions. Furthermore, the Institute hosted a training program, "Skill Enhancement Digitalization of Supply Chain Management," on August 23rd, in conjunction with the College of Engineering and Technology at the Arab Academy for Science, Technology, and Maritime Transport, the Damietta Port Authority, and the Aqaba Development Corporation, welcoming participants from Aqaba, Jordan, and Damietta, Egypt.

The Port Training Institute's global engagement also featured prominently with Prof. Alaa Morsy, its Dean, participating in the 7th International Cooperation Forum for the Maritime Silk Road from July 17th to 19th, 2023. Organized by the Global Shipping Think Tank Alliance and supported by the Ministry of Transport of the People's Republic of China, this prestigious forum brought together organizations and institutions from China and Europe, with Prof. Alaa Morsy being the sole Arab participant, highlighting the Institute's unique role in fostering international cooperation. Furthermore, the Institute expanded its collaboration with China by hosting an online joint training program with the Qingdao Technical Training Institute, covering "Modern Systems in Port Equipment Maintenance Planning" from July 30th to August 3rd, 2023. This program drew participants from Egypt, Yemen, and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, strengthening the Port Training Institute's global reach and impact.
